Jose does not have a singular genre of preference in his work which may include landscapes, seascapes, portraiture, abstracts, people or just anything that may excite his senses. Jose approaches all art genres with the same fresh feeling of awe. His art is found in private collections in Australia, USA, Chile and India.

Class outcomes:

This class will each students an introduction to the basic acrylic techniques.

Materials list:

- Paints: Cadmium red medium, quinacridone, magenta/violet, ultramarine, cerulean blue, lemon yellow or cadmium yellow light, cadmium yellow medium/ deep, titanium white, phthalo blue, transparent red oxide. Acrylic Retarder - Derivan, Matisse or Atelier or student's own choice. For oils, get odourless turps (Bunnings) or citrus turps
- Brushes – assorted oil/acrylic brushes, flat and round
- Canvas/boards – 30 x 40, 40 x 50cm or smaller. Gesso primed.
- Palette
- Water containers to rinse brushes.
- Pencil 2B
- Kneadable rubber
- Fine water spray bottle
- Masking tape
- Kitchen Sponge
- Old towel
- Notebook and pen
- Old sheet to use as dropsheet on the floor
