Class outcomes:

If you would like to learn to paint in watercolours, then this could be the class for you. You will be shown the basics of painting in watercolours; from which paints and brushes to use, experimentation with colour and paint consistency and practice with wet and dry applications. By the end of the term you will have a good grasp and understanding of the medium.

Materials list:

- Paints: For beginners, a basic watercolour set of 6 colours in tubes. Artist quality is best.
- Watercolour palette
- Paper: Watercolour pad, or for a better result, Arches Paper 300g cold pressed.
- Brushes: For beginners, a basic set of watercolour brushes is fine. For a better result, Art Basics Squirrel Oval Wash No10, a large Chinese brush, a size 2 small brush and a square brush No 4
- 1 x fine inexpensive natural hair brush for masking fluid
- Kneadable rubber
- Fine water spray bottle
- Masking tape
- Old hand towel
- Note book and pen, 2B pencil or watercolour pencils if you have any.
- Box of tissues or roll of soft toilet paper
- Masking fluid and small piece of soap
- 1 x fine inexpensive natural hair brush for masking fluid
